Friends of the Western Philatelic Library Board of Directors Meeting Saturday, October 22, 2016 3004 Spring Street Redwood City CA 94063

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm by **Vice President of Acquisitions Roger Skinner**.

- 1. <u>Roll Call</u> found the following <u>Officers and Directors</u> present (constituting a quorum): Dick Cleaver, Edward Jarvis, Roger Skinner, Jo Skinner, and Roy Teixeira. Board Chair Stuart Leven sent his regrets for absence (travel). Guest: Nestor Nunez.
- **2.** <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Jo Skinner reported that all accounts are up to date and although the library has no other immediate income, there are funds available through the end of December, 2016.
- 3. <u>Bay Phil</u>: It was discussed and decided to merge the **September/October** and **November/December** issues to save printing and postage costs. Also beginning in 2017 the **Bay Phil** will become a quarterly publication. The question of possible distribution by e-mail was also raised, although previous attempts at this were not successful.
- **4.** <u>Nomination to Board</u>: Board Member Edward Jarvis nominated Nestor Nunez to the Board of Directors. Seconded by Roger Skinner, approved unanimously. Nestor agreed to serve as Board Secretary.
- 5. <u>Website/Webmaster</u>: Updating of the **FWPL Website** is required and **Roy Teixeira** said he will contact **David Moore**, who worked on it previously, and to ask him to continue to maintain it as **Webmaster**.
- **6.** Nestor Nunez Input: New Board member and Secretary Nestor Nunez, a professional C.P.A., emphasized the necessity for organization of records including Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws in order to file Federal Tax returns and the 990 forms as well as State forms. "Housekeeping" must be done, including maintaining up to date Minutes of Board Meetings, to meet requirement for regaining 501(c)3 status.
- 7. <u>Donations/Fundraising</u>: The members discussed possible avenues for donations and fundraising and decided that they should be put off until the 501(c)3 status is regained. The possibility of requesting a Federal Grant was raised in view of the Library being designated an official project of Save America's Treasures by the National Trust For Historic Preservation.
- **8.** <u>Volunteers:</u> Ideas for recruiting new volunteers from the active local **Sequoia Stamp** Club were discussed including offering a meeting place at the **Library.**

- 9. Open House/ Sale: The next Open House/ Library Sale is set for Saturday February 18, 2017.
- 10. <u>Next Board of Directors Meeting</u>: Dick Cleaver asked that the next Board of Directors Meeting be held at the Library on Saturday, November 19, 2016.
- 11. <u>Adjournment</u>: Jo Skinner moved for adjournment, seconded by Nestor Nunez. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 3:00 pm.
